DRUG AND ALCOHOL POLICY

ISSAQUAH SCHOOL DISTRICT REAFFIRMS ITS ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY INVOLVING DRUGS AND ALCOHOL AT SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

For the past several years, secondary schools within the Issaquah School District have seen an increase in the number of students who have been impacted by the use of controlled substances. To address this issue, community members, community agencies and school administrators met over the 1995-96 school year to review school district policies and discipline procedures and to coordinate community resources related to these drug and alcohol concerns.

- During the 2005-2006 school year, students who violate student conduct rules by possessing, using or being under the influence of drugs or alcohol, at any middle or high school activity, will be put on emergency expulsion from school.
- The emergency expulsion may be modified, through a hearing process, to a long-term suspension from school for duration of up to 60 days at the middle schools and 90 days at the high schools.
- The long-term suspension may be reduced if a student and the parent(s) agree that the student will complete a drug and alcohol assessment and to agree to follow through with any treatment plan that may be necessary.

Several community agencies are available to students and parents who may need assistance and resources. Local agencies will assist the District by coordinating these services and in making students aware of these services available to them. In addition a \$50,000 State grant will fund district-wide activities to address drug and alcohol issues at each school site.
